

## Thanks for choosing the Official Verizon Wireless Music Center Campground. We're glad you're here!

Please review this sheet for some simple campground rules, suggestions and guidelines. Please always refer to the literature that you receive upon arrival as all information below is subject to change. Please enjoy your stay!

### General Information:

- A map of the venue can be found on the back of this page. Please use it to find your way around the property. Important locations may include will-call for ticket pickup.
- Vending is not permitted on the music center grounds.
- First Aid is on-call should any medical needs arise. Please visit any of the security/first aid tents or the campground entrance for assistance.
- Medical and security staff are on-site throughout the duration of your stay. Feel free to approach them with any needs.
- You have been provided black and blue trash bags. The black bags are to be used for trash and the blue for recyclables. Recyclables include plastic and glass bottles, cardboard, paper, newspaper and aluminum cans. Please find receptacles for both recycling and trash throughout the campground.
- All events are rain or shine.
- The following items are prohibited in the campground: Weapons of any kind, fireworks, illegal drugs, controlled substances, nitrous oxide, fires, alcoholic beverages, glass or metal containers, incendiary devices and pets; however service animals are always permitted. Remember that it is illegal to drink or have open containers of alcoholic beverages in public including the parking lot, camping area, in your vehicle or outside the venue. Uniformed and plainclothes officers as well as officers from the Alcoholic Beverage Control will be patrolling the parking lots, campgrounds and inside the venue. Please obey all the laws for your own safety and enjoyment.
- Ice and other amenities may be available near the entrance to the campground. Other amenities include showers, portable restroom facilities and drinking water. Please see the map provided upon arrival for details.
- For your safety, we kindly request that you remain on-site and avoid walking on surrounding roadways during your stay.
- All on-site parking lots will be cleared immediately following the show, please cooperate. After all, you have a long drive to Alpine Valley the next day.
- Please do not arrive before the campground or parking lot opening times.
- The parking lots for the Alpine Valley shows will open at 3:00 pm both days. Travel time to Alpine Valley is approximately five hours from VWMC. Please do not arrive early. Tickets are \$49.50 for reserved and lawn seating. Gates are at 5:30 pm & the show starts at 7:00 pm.

## Phish Show Information

### Beware

Please beware of the following items while visiting the Official Verizon Wireless Music Center Campground.

- **Counterfeit Tickets**—please only purchase tickets from authorized Live Nation outlets. If you purchase a ticket from anyone other than Live Nation, you do so at your own risk.
- **Nitrous Oxide**—cuts off the flow of oxygen to the brain. Numerous medical emergencies have occurred due to its ingestion ranging from concussions (falling down after passing out), to in extreme cases, death. If you purchase nitrous oxide you are likely supporting people who will contribute nothing to the Phish fan community.
- **Walking on Roadways**—while you may be paying attention, drivers may not. Our campgrounds are self-contained and we recommend that you stay on-site for the duration of your stay.
- **Please do not wait until the last minute to come to the show. You will be searched for contraband at the gates. Avoid long lines and come in early!**

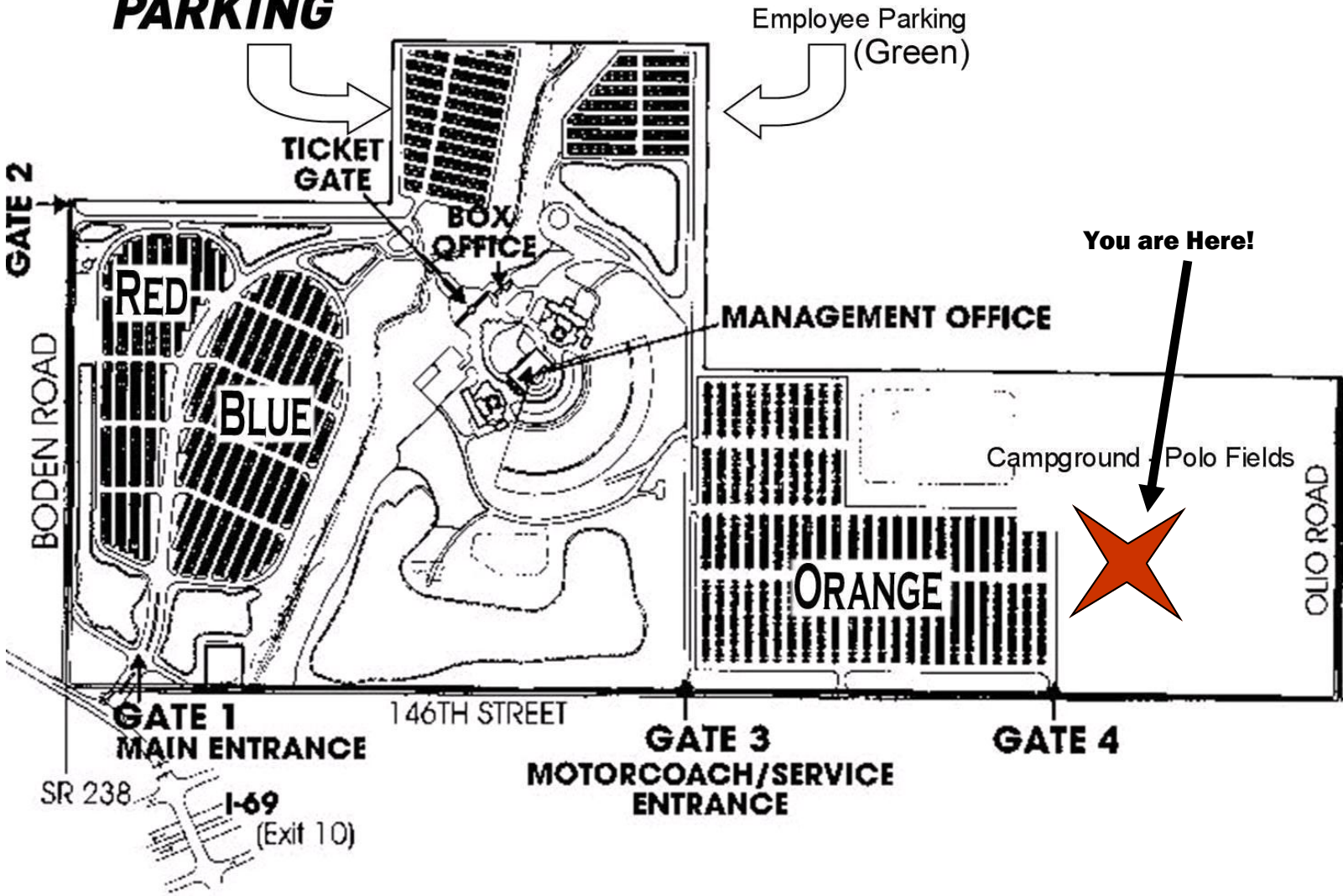
